5. How long do you have to setup?
6. Do you need to bring any special equipment?
7. Is your Tech Rider up to date and have you submitted it?

There is a standard sequence to setting up your channels. While everyone may not follow them, you will look more professional if you used this layout, for the companies who do. It is also a great way to show FOH how you are setup.

- Drums
- Bass
- Guitars
- Keyboard
- Piano
- Other instruments
- Lead Vocal
- Background vocals
- Pastor / spoken word
- Effects
- Media (Computer, DVD player, CD player, etc.)

### Tech Rider

Do you have a professional tech rider? A tech rider is a list of technical stage instructions that allows the venue where you will be performing in, as well as the engineers who might work the gig, to be ready for your technical requirements. It's a document that contains all of the relevant information on your band and it is an incredibly important communication tool.
